**Route 7, Wilton  
Nighttime Lane Closures Scheduled  
March 25 – March 29, 2007**

**Wilton, Connecticut** – Connecticut Department of Transportation officials have announced that there will be nighttime lane closures on Route 7 in the Cannondale area, between Cannon Road to just north of Olmstead Hill Road, **Sunday through Thursday, from March 25 – 29, 2007**. The work will take place from **9:30pm to 6:00am each night**, *weather permitting*.

There will be alternating one-way traffic through the work zone and Wilton police will be on site for traffic control during this time. Access to residential and commercial driveways will be maintained. The lane closures are necessary in order to dig test pits in the roadway.

The work is part of the overall project to widen Route 7 in Wilton that will accommodate two travel lanes, both northbound and southbound, for a length of approximately three miles from Wolfpit Road to Olmstead Hill Road. The project is scheduled for completion in April 2010.

Please use caution when traveling through the construction work zone to ensure the safety of motorists and construction personnel.
