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Route 7, Wilton Night time Drainage and Water Main Work Starting

Wilton, Connecticut – The Connecticut Department of Transportation officials are announcing that the contractor will be closing lanes at various locations along Route 7 and on Route 33 to complete drainage and water main work. The night work is scheduled for **Monday through Thursday**, from **8:00pm to 6:00am**, weather permitting.

Route 7 Detour in effect Monday April 6 and Tuesday April 7, 2009

- Route 7 northbound and southbound traffic will be detoured onto Cannon Road and Seeley Road during the night to complete work in this area. Detour signs will be posted and Wilton police officers will be present to direct and maintain traffic.

Motorists should anticipate minor delays, due to alternating one-way traffic and intermittent traffic stoppages.

The work is part of the overall project to widen Route 7 in Wilton that will accommodate two travel lanes, both northbound and southbound, for a length of approximately three miles from Wolfpit Road to Olmstead Hill Road. The project is scheduled for completion in 2010.

Please use caution when traveling through the construction work zone to ensure the safety of motorists and construction personnel.

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
