**Route 7, Wilton
Paving Scheduled At Night
November 9, 2007**

Wilton, Connecticut – Connecticut Department of Transportation officials have announced that a portion of Route 7, between Wolfpit Road and Deerfield Road, will be paved on Friday night, **November, 9, 2007** from **8:00pm to 6:00am**. This section of the roadway has been impacted by water main work in association with the widening and reconstruction project and is being paved to provide a better riding surface. The work will take place, *weather permitting*.

There will be one-way alternating traffic through the area during this timeframe and Wilton police will be available to direct traffic and assist motorists.

The work is part of the overall project to widen Route 7 in Wilton that will accommodate two travel lanes, both northbound and southbound, for a length of approximately three miles from Wolfpit Road to Olmstead Hill Road. The project is scheduled for completion in April 2010.

Please use caution and follow the posted speed limit when traveling through the construction work zone to ensure the safety of motorists and construction personnel.
