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Traffic Shift Scheduled For Route 33, Ridgefield Road

Wilton, Connecticut – Connecticut Department of Transportation officials have announced that the **existing travel lanes will be shifted** on Route 33, Ridgefield Road, west of Route 7, **beginning on or about Monday, December 18, 2006**. The number of travel lanes will remain the same, but will be reduced to 11' wide and shifted to the south side of the existing roadway.

Temporary precast concrete barrier curb will be installed on the north side of the road to delineate and protect the work area. The realignment of travel lanes is necessary for the construction of a retaining wall along the northwest corner of Route 33, Ridgefield Road and Route 7.

The work is part of the overall project to widen Route 7 in Wilton that will accommodate two travel lanes, both northbound and southbound, for a length of approximately three miles from Wolfpit Road to Olmstead Hill Road. The project is scheduled for completion in April 2010.

Please use caution when traveling through the construction work zone to ensure the safety of motorists and construction personnel.
