**Route 7, Wilton
Nighttime Lane Closure Scheduled
Week of April 9, 2007**

Wilton, Connecticut – Connecticut Department of Transportation officials have announced that there will be a nighttime lane closure on Route 7 between Route 33 and Old Highway, on or about **Wednesday, April 11**, from 9:30pm to 6:00am, **weather permitting**. There will be alternating one-way traffic through the work zone and Wilton police will be on site for traffic control during this time. The closure is necessary to shift traffic to the west side of Route 7, in order to work on the east side of the road.

The work is part of the overall project to widen Route 7 in Wilton that will accommodate two travel lanes, both northbound and southbound, for a length of approximately three miles from Wolfpit Road to Olmstead Hill Road. The project is scheduled for completion in April 2010.

Please use caution when traveling through the construction work zone to ensure the safety of motorists and construction personnel.
