**Route 7, Wilton
Traffic Shift Scheduled
On Or About June 7, 2007**

Wilton, Connecticut – Connecticut Department of Transportation officials have announced that there will be a traffic shift on Route 7, between Allen's Meadows and Cannon Road, on or about **June 7, 2007**. Traffic will be shifted to the west side of the road, in order to begin work on the east side of Route 7 in this vicinity. It is anticipated that the road will remain in this configuration for the next few months. Roadway widening, bridge work, drainage and water main installation continue at various locations throughout the project limits.

The work is part of the overall project to widen Route 7 in Wilton that will accommodate two travel lanes, both northbound and southbound, for a length of approximately three miles from Wolfpit Road to Olmstead Hill Road. The project is scheduled for completion in April 2010.

Please use caution and follow the posted speed limit when traveling through the construction work zone to ensure the safety of motorists and construction personnel.
